Navigation buttons direct the browser to:

Contact information for Clinics & Agencies, Categories of Professionals, North Sound Mental Health Administration information, and Cross Listings between service providers and Client Issues.

Color-coded buttons to the various categories of professionals provide information about, and hyperlinks to: Psychiatrists, Psychologists, Registered Nurses, Licensed Mental Health Counselors, Licensed Social Workers, Licensed Marriage and Family Therapists, Chemical Dependency Professionals, and Registered Counselors, who have licenses through Washington State Department of Health.

The “North Sound Mental Health Administration” button directs the browser to information about the agencies authorized to provide publicly-funded mental health services within Whatcom county.

A list of 48 “Client Issues” are cross-referenced with the agencies and professionals who are qualified to assist clients with their needs. (Examples: ADD/ADHD, Depression, PTSD, Trauma)

The “Clinics & Agencies” button leads to a directory of clinics, agencies, and private practices in Whatcom County. Each business includes contact information and lists affiliate service providers with hyperlinks to detailed descriptions about them.

Additional resources are listed and linked through the “Other Help” button.

The Whatcom Mental Health Providers Directory provides a profile listing of each qualified professional, including Name, Credential, Washington State Dept of Health License name and number, Contact Information, Availability and Payment Options, and Descriptions regarding the type of Clients Served and the Methods and Practices used.

Below is a sample box that opens when an individual professional profile is selected:
